

Hello everyone,

Helping children build inner strength to cope with the 'ups and downs' of growing up is one of the best things parents can do.

Help children feel they are loved and belong, One of the most important things is a sense of belonging. When children learn to belong it gives them the ability to make attachments, trust others and be able to form relationships with other people in their life. Children need to feel good about themselves and know that someone is there for them and comes when they cry, comforts them when they are lonely. Children need to know that they are loved for who they are and feel they have a place in the family - and that they will be missed if they are away and they have a part in what needs to be done, eg. family chores.

Please come in and see Jo if you would like to make payments by EFT.


