- adding the emergency information hotline 1800 000 279 to your contacts.

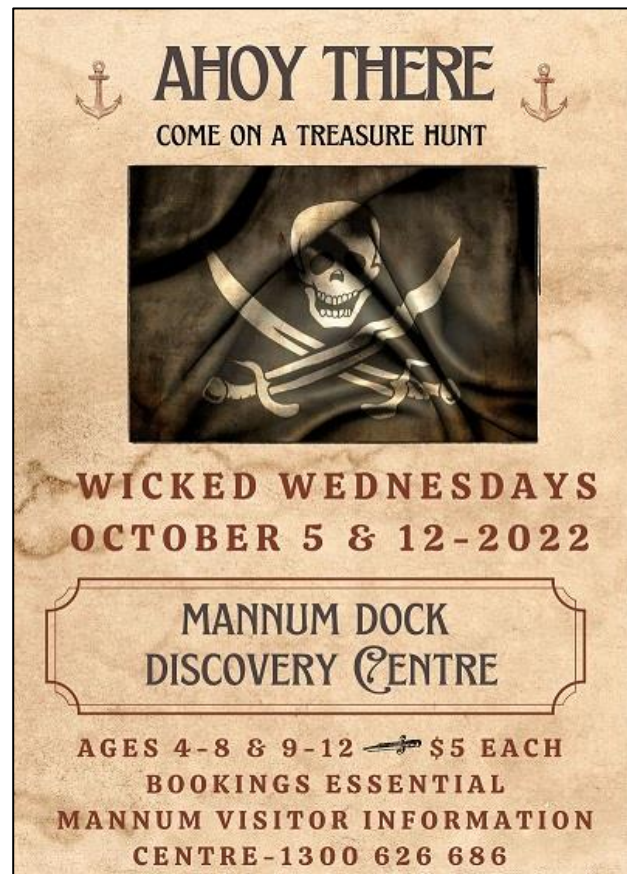
